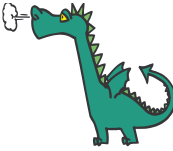

## Fairy Tale Creatures

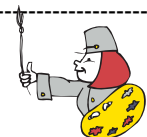
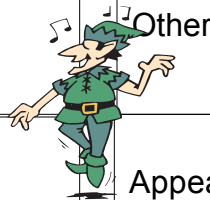
Objectives: ...use text organizers (including headings graphic features, tables of content) to locate and organize information

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## The Leadership of a Servant

Objective: ...draw inferences (conclusions or generalizations) and support them with text evidence and personal experience.
